Disbursement Charges (charges paid on your behalf such as crematorium fees/celebrant/flowers/orders of service, etc.) are in addition to the above. We require payment in advance for all charges over and above £2000, with a minimum advance payment of £1000 required in all cases no later than 24 hours before the funeral takes place. We are pleased to offer a discount of £100 where the account is settled in full prior to the funeral taking place. We reserve the right to add a credit surcharge in cases where the account is to be settled by a solicitor.

SIMPLE FUNERAL

Our simple funeral includes making the funeral arrangements and carrying the funeral out; collection and care of the deceased, provision of a simple coffin, and the hearse direct to a local cemetery or crematorium for the service at a time agreed with the family. **£1995.00**

1. The funeral service will take place Monday to Friday at a time mutually agreeable with the client.
2. The Simple Funeral specifically excludes use of the chapel of rest for viewing purposes.
3. The only permitted additional services will be the provision of one limousine, out of hours' removal, and provision of a container for cremated remains. All of these services will be charged at our standard rate.
4. We request that clients make their own arrangements for additional items such as flowers, catering, intimations, orders of service, etc.
5. A surcharge of £75 will apply in the case of a burial to cover the cost of additional coffin furnishings.
6. The only permitted disbursements will be the crematorium / cemetery fee, and celebrant fees.
7. We will require a minimum payment in advance of the funeral of £1000. This must be paid no later than 24 hours before the funeral takes place. Any additional services required will be added to the deposit.
8. We reserve the right to add a credit surcharge of £200 in cases where the account is to be settled by a solicitor.

UNATTENDED DIRECT CREMATION

Our unattended direct cremation service includes collection and care of the deceased, provision of a simple coffin, making all necessary arrangements, and transportation of the deceased at the allocated time to a local crematorium of our choosing. No service will take place at the crematorium, and the cremated remains may be returned to the family afterwards.

UNATTENDED DIRECT BURIAL

Our unattended direct burial service includes collection and care of the deceased, provision of a simple coffin, making all necessary arrangements, and transportation of the deceased to a local cemetery for committal at a time of our choosing. No service will take place at the cemetery.
